Arrangements during Bad Weather in S1, 2020-21

I) For classes that have not yet started

- a) If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force during the following time periods, or
- b) When an announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory during the following time periods that the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above is likely to be issued within the next two hours, classes will be arranged as indicated:

	Online Teaching (in September 2020)	Face-to-face + Online Teaching (from 1 October 2020 onwards)
Whole Day	Continue online. Teachers will record the lectures and upload the videos to SOUL for students' revision.	For face-to-face teaching: teaching will be changed to online only. Teachers will record the lectures and upload the videos to SOUL for students' revision.

II) For classes that have already started

	Online Teaching (in September 2020)	Face-to-face + Online Teaching (from 1 October 2020 onwards)
When an announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above is likely to be issued within the next two hours	Continue online. Teachers will record the lectures and upload the videos to SOUL for students' revision.	For online teaching: continue online. For face-to-face teaching: continue until Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 is officially issued, then classes will be suspended immediately.* Teachers will record the lectures and upload the videos to SOUL for students' revision.
When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above is in force	Same as above	Immediately suspended
When the Black Rainstorm Signal is in force	Same as above	For online teaching: continue online. For face-to-face teaching: continue. Teachers will record the lectures and upload the videos to SOUL for students' revision.

Remarks	(*) It will be at the discretion of students, particularly those living on outlying islands or in remote areas, to leave earlier

III) Classes resumption

When an announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is lowered during the following time periods, classes will be arranged as indicated:

Time for Lowered Warning Signal Announcement	Online Teaching (in September 2020)	Face to Face + Online Teaching (from 1 October 2020 onwards)
Before 6:00 am	Classes that start from 8:30 am onwards will be held as scheduled.	
6:00 am – 10:59 am	Classes that start from 1:00 pm onwards will be held as scheduled.*	
11:00 am – 2:59 pm	Classes that start from 6:00 pm onwards will be held as scheduled.	
3:00 pm & onwards	Cancel on that day will be cancelled.	
Remarks	(*) Classes that start before 1:00 pm but with the remaining lesson time (calculated from 1:00 pm) equal to or more than 1 hour and 30 minutes will be resumed at 1:00 pm.	

IV) Examinations

The delivery mode of examinations will be announced nearer the examination period. Students should check their emails regularly so that the updated information of examinations can be received.

V) Make-up Arrangements for Cancelled Class and Examination

No make-up classes will be arranged for classes cancelled due to bad weather.

Make-up examination schedule will be announced later via SOUL 2.0. Students should check make-up examination schedule via SOUL 2.0 regularly.
